In conjunction with the Community Food Bank, a Food Distribution Center will be opening in July in the West University neighborhood. The center will be located next door to the West University Neighborhood Association office in the Trinity Mission Center at 400 East University. The center will distribute boxes of food to needy families in our area. You may have been hearing the recent news stories about increased hunger issues and food shortages across the globe. This is our opportunity to help those in need in our own neighborhood and community.



The Food Distribution Center will be open three days a week for four hours each day on Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday from 12 – 4 p.m. We need volunteers to commit to either a two hour shift or an entire four hour shift once a month. If you can only commit to every other month or a just a few months out of the year, that's fine too. Any help at all you can give to those in need will be greatly appreciated!

Volunteer work needed:

- At least two people per shift to hand out the food boxes and check people into the Community Food Bank system.
- Drivers with trucks, vans or trailers to deliver food boxes from the Community Food Bank to the Food Distribution Center at Trinity.

Times for food delivery may be different than center hours and may be somewhat flexible.

Training will be provided . A training session is initially scheduled for June 21 from 9 – 11a.m. (with breakfast). Don't worry if you can't make training on that day, we will get you trained.
