I. Picnic and Potluck Lunch

By general invitation, WUNA members and other neighbors in the West University neighborhood gathered for the Annual Meeting starting at 1:00 p.m. At approximately 1:30 p.m., while those present were enjoying burgers, hot dogs, and a potluck lunch, Judy Sensibar, the outgoing WUNA president, introduced Brad Lancaster of Neighborhood Foresters. Brad gave those present an introduction to his organization and its goals to bring back and enhance life in our public commons in a way that enhances health and accessibility, abates the effects of climate change, sequesters carbon, and improves water/food security and flood mitigation. Brad stated that objectives are to plant in a way that all vegetation will be watered by passively harvested water within two years, and to improve local water resources by contributing water to the aquifer.
