While we mostly kept to the virtual world for our WUNA board meetings, many neighbors ventured into the real world for multiple cleanups this year. We ordered and managed to fill up two roll-off dumpsters: one over the Memorial Day Weekend and another in November. Vineyard Church sponsored both the fall and spring clean ups, and generously supplied us with trash pickers, rakes, and many enthusiastic volunteers. With the help of several members from the Kappa Alpha and Zeta Psi fraternities, we were also able to keep our rainwater retention basins at Catalina Park weeded and clean, and over the course of a few hours one November afternoon, added 20 new plants to the GIS project.

The Anza Dog Park opened to much fanfare and several news stations covered the improvements. WUNA continues to work with Parks and Recreation and TPD to keep Anza on track for its new public restroom. Parks finally broke ground for this long-awaited, necessary amenity last month. We hope to use some of our fundraising budget to help install shade ramadas over the dog park picnic tables and plan for more lighting. During our long stretch of hot days, we want to encourage people to enjoy the park safely once the sun goes down.
